Toys

At the Naracoorte Toy Library you can borrow from a vast array of well-made toys that have been designed to support your child's skill development and imagination.

The Toy Library has quality educational and fun items for loan. There is a range of items covering all stages of growth and development.

Toy Library membership is free and allows you to borrow three toys for a two week loan on a child's card.

To ensure the toy collection is maintained in good condition the following applies to borrowing toys:

- The parent / guardian is responsible to pay for toys damaged / lost / missing pieces
- Toys must be returned clean with any packaging
- Toys need to be borrowed before playing with them
- It is the responsibility of the parent / guardian to choose age appropriate toys and supervise child whilst playing with toys
- Toys need to be returned on the front counter during Library open hours
- The supply of batteries is the responsibility of borrowers
