Temporary relocation and next steps for the Library

Come and take a look at the Naracoorte Public Library now! The Library successfully relocated to 165 Smith Street, which is adjacent to the intersection at Smith and Rolland Streets. Thank you to all the volunteers, contractors and employees who helped. Watch this space because signage is coming soon!

Until a return chute is installed at the current Library books can still be returned via the chute at the library building on DeGaris Place.

At the August meeting of the Naracoorte Lucindale Council the Elected Members committed to taking the next step to an improved Naracoorte Public Library / Community Resource Centre.

The maximum budget for the project is \$2 million. The first step towards an improved Naracoorte Public Library / Community Resource Centre will be to develop schematic and detailed designs that are within the \$2 million project budget.

Until such time that an improved Naracoorte Public Library / Community Resource Centre is completed the library will remain at its temporary premises of 165 Smith Street, Naracoorte.
